Introduction

Run York, Run York Plus and Heworth Harriers are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. Should we ask you to provide personal data for the purposes of your membership we will store and process that data in a fair, lawful, secure and transparent way.

What personal data we hold on you

You may give us information about you by filling in an online form, or by corresponding with us by phone, email or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you register with the group or renew your annual membership. The information you give us may include your name, date of birth, address, e-mail address and phone number. We may also ask for relevant health information and emergency contact details.

Why we need your personal data

We need your personal data to administer your membership, and provide information about club activities. Our lawful basis for processing your personal personal data is that we need the data to provide the services you have registered for.

Any health and emergency contact data we hold on you is only processed for the purpose(s) of allowing the safe running of training sessions. We process this data on the lawful basis of consent. Therefore, we will also need your explicit consent to process this data, which we will ask for at the point of collecting it.

How long we hold your personal data

We will hold your personal data on file for as long as you are a member with us. Data is updated every year on annual membership forms. Any personal data we hold will be securely destroyed after two years of inactivity on that member's account. Your data is not processed for any further purposes other than those detailed in this policy.

Your rights regarding your personal data

As a data subject you may have the right at any time to request access to, rectification or erasure of your personal data; to restrict or object to certain kinds of processing of your personal data; to the portability of your personal data and to complain to the UK's data protection supervisory authority, the Information Commissioner's Office about the processing of your personal data.

As a data subject you are not obliged to share your personal data with us. If you choose not to share your personal data with us we may not be able to register or administer your membership.

Change of purpose

We will only use your personal data for the purposes for which we collected it, unless we reasonably consider that we need to use it for another reason and that reason is compatible with the original purpose.

If we need to use your personal data for a purpose unrelated to that for which we collected the data, we will notify you and will explain the legal ground of processing.

We may process your personal data without your knowledge or consent where this is required or permitted by law.
